# Self-Inflicted Crane Damage Repaired by Stitching


As this crane was in use, its free hook caught on a stationary piece of equipment, resulting in considerable damage to the gear box.

Stitching - joins broken cast iron and dissimilar metal to like-new condition, on-site or in-house. Stitching restores casting strength to equal or better than original shock load capacity. Parts are stitched on-site or inhouse, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The result is a permanent repair with a one year guarantee.

### THE PROBLEM

As a result of the crane hook accident, the gear box was broken into 13 pieces.
